Class Information: All classes are NRHA approved except for Green as Grass Horse & Rider, Ladies and Mens. All classes will be run following NRHA rules. In Green as Grass Rider/Horse, Ladies and Mens classes exhibitors may ride two handed and use any approved bit. (Rider cannot change method, one-handed vs. two-handed during the pattern.)

Classes grouped together are run concurrent - one judge's fee is charged in concurrent classes.

Green as Grass Rider is for the rider who has not won more than \$100 in any reining event at the start of the current year.

Green as Grass Horse is for the horse that has won more than \$100 in any reining event or more than 5 breed points at the start of the year.

Show Retainage: Show committee will retain 50% of the entries on all classes.

Schedule of Class Closings: Green as Grass Rider will close at 7:30pm evening prior. The draw for Green as Grass Rider will be posted by 8:30pm. All other entries close at the beginning of the preceding class.

NRHA Memberships & Licenses: All horses must be licensed through the NRHA, and riders and owners must be current members of the NRHA except for the following classes: Ladies, Mens & Green as Grass. Membership applications are available at the show.

Stalls/Tack Stalls/Paid Warm Ups: All stalls are \$100.00 for the weekend or \$40 for a day. Tie outs are not allowed by NEC. Horses may arrive after 8:00am on Friday, May 7. No outside shavings are permitted - stalls must have at least two bags of shavings - shavings are purchased through NEC at \$7.50 per bag. **Stall reservations are requested!! Please call Gwyn Haskins 314.795.5543 for stall, paid warm up & shaving reservations.**

Paid warm ups will be held Friday, May 7 from 2:00 - 4:00pm and 6:00 - 8:00pm. If we have enough requests a morning session from 10:00-12:00 will be held. Main arena will be closed during paid warm ups.

About The National Equestrian Center: The National Equestrian Center (NEC) is located off Interstate 64 (40/61), in Lake St. Louis, Missouri. From I-64 (40/61) exit at Lake St. Louis Boulevard, turn left onto Lake St. Louis Blvd, appx 0.2 miles - NEC is on your left. NEC is approximately 30 miles from St. Louis, 211 miles from Kansas City and 213 miles from Springfield, MO.

Facilities for Arena A include 120'x240' heated indoor pen, 100'x200' warm up pen and 240 stalls under one roof. Restrooms & showers and wash racks are easily accessible in the barn area.
